WHAT IS THE KINGDOM VISION PROJECT?

The Kingdom Vision Project is a compilation of Kingdom visions collected from brothers and sisters from around the ecclesial world. They can take on any form including written, illustration, or mixed media. It also includes artwork from Sunday School and youth group aged children and teenagers.

HOW WILL THE VISIONS BE SHARED?

We have two main aims for the project:

BOOK FORM — the visions are being put into a book that will be made available to all the contributors and can be shared around the brotherhood. Initially, this will most likely be in the form of an e-book but we hope to look at publishing it in printed form in the future.

All submissions will appear in the book anonymously unless otherwise requested.

BLOG FORM —the visions may also appear on the Wilderness Voice blog: *The Voice*. These are best published with the authors name.

If you would like your contribution to be included in one and not the other please specify when you send it in, otherwise we will assume you are comfortable with both.

A few notes & ideas to get you started & help overcome writers block!

The following pages contain different scenarios & questions that might help you get started. These are just a guide, not a prescription you must follow. You might only use one question—you might use none!

HOW & WHAT YOU WRITE IN YOUR KINGDOM VISION IS ENTIRELY UP TO YOU.

Your vision could take on ANY of these forms:

- a story
- a poem
- a prayer
- song lyrics
- a quote medley
- a letter
- a drawing
- etc.

It might be long or it might be very short.
Think of a good title for your vision (other than 'Kingdom vision')

Then...

1. Turning this Mortal into Immortal

Some questions to consider:

- How does it feel?
- What are your associated emotions?
- What parts of your body are affected first?
 - How does it affect your senses?
 - Taste / touch / smell / hear / see

If you want to add some context:

- Is anyone else with you?
- Where have you come from?
 - Where are you going?
 - Who are you with?

2. Describing the scene before you. What do you see?

Choose a category or make your own:

- A multitude of saints
 - The temple
 - New Jerusalem
 - Trees on riverbank
- A glassy sea of nations
- The throne of God / the Lamb
- Nations flowing to the Temple
 - The Judgement seat
 - Marriage feast
 - Garden of Eden

Some questions to consider:

- What are you doing here?
- What do you see / smell / taste / hear?
 - How does it make you feel?
 - Who is with you?
- What are you excited for?
- What is the weather like?
- Where have you come from?
 - Where are you going?

3. An encounter with Christ
OR
An encounter with a bible character

Some questions to consider:

- Have you met this person before?
 - What do they look like?
 - What are they wearing?
 - Where are you?
 - How are you feeling?
 - Who are you with?
 - Who is with them?
- What language are they speaking? Can you understand them?
- How did you introduce yourself? (a kiss, a handshake, a hug)
 - Any associated sounds / smells etc?

4. Working in the Kingdom Age

Choose a category or make your own:

- Justice council
- Part of Gods army
- Around the Temple
- Around Jerusalem
- Healing the nations
- Restoring the earth
- Planning in the angel's boardroom
 - Teaching truth
 - Etc.....

Some questions to consider:

- Who are you with?
- Who commanded you to work / taught you / helped / assisted?
 - How are you feeling?
 - How does your work affect others around you?
 - How do you get there?
 - How long does it take?
- What is the final result? Or is this ongoing? How long for?
